## PACKING LIST

Please note that you can buy most of these items in towns surrounding West Boxford should you forget something. Keep it simple. No dressy clothing is needed but modest attire is required. Wear layers for warmth. If in doubt, leave it home. Don't bring anything you can't afford to lose or leave behind.

We leave it up to your group leaders as to whether or not participants can bring their phones. We ask that phones are not used at work sites.

- Pillow
- Sleeping bag or blanket
- Sheets and pillowcase
- One or two pairs of work pants or appropriate (modest) shorts
- One or two pairs of casual pants or shorts
- Underwear and socks for each day
- Appropriate work shirts – please no t-shirts with logos that represent alcohol or drugs or that others may find offensive
- Rain jacket
- Hoodie
- Swimsuit and towel
- Pajamas or other sleeping attire – please be modest, everyone sleeps in one room
- Toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant)
- Washcloth and towel
- Bathroom flip flops
- Closed toed shoes (All work sites require this. No flip flops allowed at worksites.)
- Sunscreen, Chapstick, bug spray
- Sunglasses
- All prescription medications and over the counter medications
- Hat
- Reusable water bottle
- Something to read/journal
- Spending money
- Backpack to keep your stuff organized during the day. A cinch sack works best.

### We will provide:

- Environmentally friendly hair and body soaps for the outdoor showers
- Sleeping mat
- Paper products (towels/toilet paper)
- Coolers for transporting lunches
- Large containers for filling water bottles at work sites
- Cleaning supplies
- Coffee pot/pots and pans/dishes
- First aid kit
